MATCH REPORT: After being sent off for a red card for swearing, the player continued to sit on the bench. When asked to leave, the player went to get into the face of my AR and then threatened to see my AR and me in the parking lot after the game.

AR Report: In the 65th min, the referee sent off [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] for using foul and abusive language directed at the referee. After protesting for a short period of time on the field, [REDACTED] left the field and remained in the bench area. After overhearing, the AR1 informed the referee that the player needed to leave the vicinity of the field, [REDACTED] then came approximately 10 yards from his technical area to the AR1 to get in the AR1's face to argue and then threatened both the referee and AR1 claiming he would meet them in the parking lot after the game. The referees then engaged the assistance of the team captain and other peacemakers to direct [REDACTED] to leave the field. After 7-min long delay, [REDACTED] finally left the vicinity of the field. He did not follow through with his threat.
